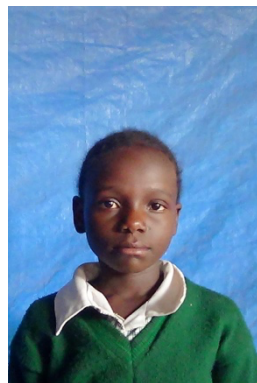

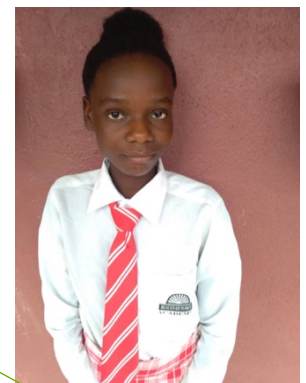
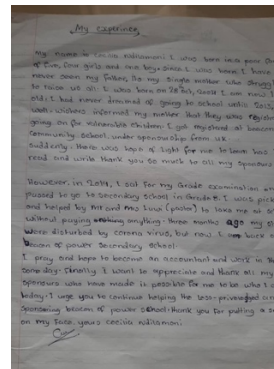


Here is an update from our newsletter issue 21 that was sent out in April 2020.

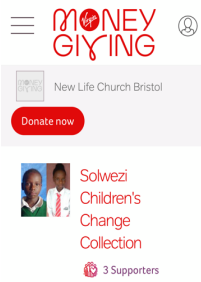
My experience

My name is Cecilia Ndilamoni I was born into a poor family of five, four girls and one boy. Since I was born I have never seen my father, it's my single mother who struggled to raise us all. I was born on 28th Oct 2004 I am now 16 years old. I had never dreamed of going to school until 2013 when well-wishers informed my mother that there was registration going on for vulnerable children. I got registered at beacon community school, under sponsorship from UK. Suddenly there was hope of light for me to learn how to read and write thank you so much to all my sponsors.

However in 2019, I sat for grade examination and passed to go to secondary school in Grade 8. I was picked and helped by Mr and Mrs Luwi (pastor) to take me at school without paying anything. Three months ago my studies were disturbed by Corona virus, but now I am back at beacon of power secondary school.

I pray and hope to become an accountant and work in the bank some day. Finally I want to appreciate and thank all my sponsors who have made it possible for me to be who I am today.
